Volunteers are needed to greet the donors and collect the gifts. A cardboard angel is placed on the tree with information pertaining to the child. The gift may be other than what is suggested on the tag as long as it is suitable for that age child. The gift must be returned to the volunteer before December 19 for distribution to the families. The donor selects an angel from the tree, checks out with the volunteer, purchases a toy or clothing item, and returns it to the table unwrapped. The volunteer attaches part of the tag to the gift for delivery to the family. The Kids' Community Dental Clinic, a non-profit community clinic for Medi-Cal and low income and uninsured children has several programs centered on the education, prevention, detection, intervention and restoration of tooth decay and oral health problems in low income children. Core programs include: 1) School-linked Oral Health



Education & Outreach, 2) Parenting and Baby programs (called Babies R Free this teaches parents how to prevent tooth decay at the appearance of the first tooth); 3) Dental Career Mentoring; and 4) Pediatric Dental Clinic (for direct services (dental treatments).

Dental career mentoring is offered to local students at the high school, college undergrad and graduate level who seek hands on experience in a dental environment. They are trained to impact children in community clinic; school; and outreach settings. Below is a photo of 3 "pre-dental" students on tour at the University of California at San Francisco's School of Dentistry. L to R: Clesther is a graduate of John Burroughs High School and UCLA; Nicole, from Texas is a graduate of University of Texas at Austin; and Amber, a JBHS alum and undergrad at CSUN together toured two, Bay-area dental schools. 


