The concept drawing depicts several sea creatures cleaning up their beach by removing trash and using recycling containers. Erik has conducted several brainstorming meetings to

sharpen the focus of our float's message. These early meetings also identified several possible scenes for the back side and off-camera side of the float. After the Decoration and Construction Chairman positions are filled, the three chairmen and their committees will meet to explore animation effects, color schemes and possible floral treatments.




still many things to do and we can always use your help!


