

The Burbank YMCA – Always Here for Our Community



Part of the YMCA's charitable mission is to unlock people's potential, in order to improve lives and create a more connected society. Forming part of a community or special group can improve personal well-being, build relationships, and provide an outlet to discover purpose. The foundation of the Burbank YMCA is community. Known simply around the Burbank Y as "the Aquatics Ladies", this group of charismatic women, with ages ranging from 46 to 103, are the total embodiment of community at the Y. We had a chance to catch up with the leader of this dynamic group, Shari Brandon, who at the age of 74 has rightfully been nicknamed "The Youngster".

After a terrible car accident in 1994, Shari was told she would never be able to walk again. She knew she had two choices in front of her - "I could give up or give it everything I've got!"

Shari chose the latter. Raised on a Wisconsin dairy farm, Shari was no stranger to hard work, so she was more than up for the challenge that awaited her. Over the next two years, Shari would go on to make amazing progress. As she began taking steps towards moving her health forward, every step, however, came with extreme pain. Shari realized that she needed to find a way to relieve the stress on her lower body.

In 1996, a trainer recommended that she try using the Burbank Y's warm-water pool for physical therapy. From the moment she touched the water, Shari was hooked. Suddenly, things that she had been told she would never be able to do, were now possible. Within four years, Shari went from being a

daily pool user to one of the Y's most sought after aquatics instructors. As Shari began instructing aquatics courses, she quickly began to realize her capacity for providing emotional support for others.

Over time, a community of women began to come together. Like Shari, each of them had their own unique story and reason for why they ended up in the Burbank Y pool, but whether they were looking for it or not, "the community we've formed outside of the pool is what keeps us coming back" explained Shari. After a morning of water aerobics or water volleyball, you can find this joyful group of women enjoying breakfast and visiting at one of Burbank's many great restaurants. Every person who joins one of Shari's classes is added to her personal roster that lists their contact info and birthday. Once a month, the group gathers at Lancers for dinner to celebrate everyone who had a birthday that month. But it's not all play with these ladies, as they are each responsible for taking turns baking a birthday cake for the rest of the

This kind of emotional support and sense of belonging is very important to healthy aging. Shari explained how "the group feeds off each other. When one person is down the other picks them up." Many in the group consider one

another family, as they lean on each other to continue to live a fun, fulfilling life. This sense of family is what many say has differentiated the Burbank Y from other gyms and fitness centers. When you dive into an aquatics fitness class at the Y as an individual, you leave with an entire community behind you.

As we closed our conversation with Shari, she left us with three pieces of advice to lead a great life: 1) Laugh every day and don't take yourself too seriously, 2) Only live for today, as you don't know if you have a tomorrow, and 3) Open the door for the next person and help each other along the way. Upon thanking Shari for her time, she had one last vital piece of advice that she wanted to make sure to pass on -"Don't look back, because that's not where you're going. Keep moving forward!'



Burbank Tournament of Roses Association

I hope this month's report reaches you in time to remind you of our upcoming Craft Faire & Open House Fundraiser! The big day is Saturday, October 7, beginning at 11 AM! Get an early start on your holiday shopping with unique jewelry, candles, a variety of hand-crafted items and much more! We depend on your support to close the



gap between our annual grant money and the actual cost of building Burbank's Rose Parade float. The Craft Faire is our biggest fundraiser of the year so please help us to make it really

Prior to the Craft Faire, on that same Saturday morning, at 7 AM, Burbank's float will undergo its first road test "T1," for the Tournament's mechanical inspectors. They will be checking the suitability of the driver and observer compartments, which must be "substantially completed." The edges of the float should be defined and the inspectors will be watching for maneuverability issues as we travel down Flower St to Verdugo Ave where we will do a three-point turn in the intersection. After returning to our construction site, the chassis will be parked outside the Barn (to give the Craft Faire folks some room) and members of the Construction Team will be available to show off their handiwork and answer visitor's questions.

The Construction Team has spent most of the summer building the separate pieces of the float. After T1 is finished, we need to put things together and get the characters built! The sea otter, floating on his inner tube, will be rocked by the same mechanism that makes the water wave action. The heron and pelican will each need a mechanism to rotate their heads. The octopus will use several hydraulic cylinders in the tentacles that have complicated movements and at least one cylinder for simple movements. His rotating

head will probably use another cylinder. The flying bird atop the tall castle tower will use a hydraulic motor. Each hydraulic cylinder or motor needs two hoses to carry the high-pressure fluid to drive the movements. That's a lot of plumbing!

On the Decoration side, we are continuing to process dried materials. Teams of cutters are working on several different colors of dried statice as well as bunches of dried marigolds. Several members of the Deco Committee recently went on a field trip to Castaic Lake to collect drift wood. 

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
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

Brad Korb says 'Thank You' to Police and Fire Departments in Burbank, L.A., Glendale



During the La Tuna Canyon fire — one of the largest in Los Angeles history, burning more than 7,000 acres and requiring the evacuation of more than 700 people — Brad Korb, on stand-by evacuation alert, watched from his home as water-carrying helicopters flew overhead all night long and dozens of firemen and policemen kept a close eye on Burbank's neighborhoods.

"It was amazing how Burbank Police, the City of L.A. and Glendale worked so tirelessly through the night, coordinating with firemen and heavy equipment to save homes. They also had police on streets below to keep looky-loos out and help protect property in evacuated areas," Korb says. "They did such a spectacular job keeping us all safe. I want to extend a big, personal thank you to all of them."

Burbank Woman Calls Brad to Help Reveal the Real Ulysses S. Grant

Some people called him a butcher and a drunk. Others called him a ruthless warrior. But longtime Burbank resident Patricia Cameron, a two-time Emmy-award-winner and writer of children's TV shows (Little Mermaid, Smurfs, Beetlejuice, Free Willy, etc.), is determined to change the legacy of Ulysses S. Grant to recall

the whole man: kind and deeply romantic, with passion that "burned right off the page" in more than 300 love letters to his wife, Julia.

Cameron, who's lived in Burbank since 1978, is probably the world's foremost living expert on Grant's love letters. She has gotten special permission seven times to peruse the originals, and nearly knows them by heart. Yes, the Commanding General of the U.S. Army at the end of the Civil War was a hardnosed military tactician. Americans saw and still think of the nation's 18th president as the tough, brutal, sometimes cold man he was on the battlefield. The actual story revealed in his letters is so dramatically different that Cameron can't believe a motion picture documentary hasn't yet been made

based around the prolific letters home. So with the support of

her husband, their son, and the family savings, she's tackled the job herself with a dramatized video documentary titled "The Love Letters of Ulysses S. Grant." Its first phase was filmed on location in Grant Cottage, "starring" Grant's actual great-great-great-

great granddaughter. Now Cameron has permission for the next phase, filming at Madison Barracks where Grant and his beloved Julia lived as newlyweds.

"Several years ago, I saw Brad Korb had a transportation van, and it said if you need help with anything, call me. So I did," Cameron explains. Korb is pleased to use the Burbank Bulletin to help Cameron reach out to the Burbank business community and any other interested folks to help fund the next phase's \$36,000 budget for filming at Madison Barracks.


