

OTHER NAME...

Ever wonder where some of our local towns got their names? Here are a few!

North Hollywood: Was originally called "Lankershim," in honor of real estate developer Isaac Lankershim. Renamed when Hollywood grew in fame, since North Hollywood was just north of the movie capitol.

"Glendale" is Gaelic Glendale: meaning the valley of fertile land. In early days, the southwest section of what is now Glendale was called "Tropico."

Pasadena: The name comes from the Chippewa word for "Crown of the Valley.'

Toluca Lake: "Toluca" is a Native American word meaning fertile.

Sun Valley: This town used to be called "Roscoe," who most people say was the name of a real estate developer. But there is also a much more colorful urban legend claiming that "Roscoe" was slang for guns, and the area was so named because of two armed train robberies that happened there.

Studio City: So named because famed Hollywood actor, director and producer of such slapstick comedies as the "Keystone Kops" built his studios on what is now roughly Colfax Avenue and Ventura Boulevard. Today, CBS has studios there.

Universal City: In 1915, Hollywood learn more? Then come visit us!



entrepreneur Carl Laemmle created an actual city to house his growing Universal Studios. It had its own post office, mayor, soda fountain and even a zoo. When talkies came around in the late '20s, they canceled the tours, only to re-start them again with quite a bang in

Van Nuys: Named for real estate developer Isaac Van Nuys. ("Isaac" must have been a very popular name back

Warner Center: Harry Warner, the eldest of the well-known studio siblings Warner Brothers, owned a ranch way out there in the west valley. The now-thriving business community is named for

Tarzana: Edgar Rice Burroughs, author of the popular Tarzan series of books, had a large estate in the hills of this part of the San Fernando Valley. As a tribute to Burroughs, the town called itself Tarzana.

Burbank Tournament of Roses Association

In December we get far more volunteers than we do during the rest of the year combined. More precisely, Deco Week, the six days between Christmas and New Year's Eve is when the flood of volunteers arrives to help "build the float." If you've been reading this column

every month, you know we started building Burbank's 2019 float about six months ago. However, those December volunteers will be just in time to help apply the finishing touches; and we can really use their help!

But before Deco week, the float has another important date: On Saturday December 8 at 9:00 AM, officials from Pasadena will be at the float site to conduct the formal Second Test Drive (T2) with all crew members at their stations inside the float. As we go for a trip down Flower Street, we will demonstrate nearly a dozen effects and conduct a fire drill in which all crew members exit the float within 45 seconds!

Decorating begins with dry materials, which may be applied as early as mid-December. Fresh flowers will arrive on December 27 but will not be applied until December 28 (maybe the 29th if the weather is hot). Between delivery and application, volunteers will prepare the flowers, including removing mums from their stems and inserting nearly 11,000 roses into water-filled vials.

Before we can accept volunteers, they



must complete an emergency contact form, which for minors (age 7 to 18), must also be signed by a parent or guardian. You can save time by downloading the form from our website: www.BurbankRoseFloat.com and completing it before you come to volunteer. Our work site, "the Barn," is located at 123 W. Olive Ave. (under the

Olive Ave. overpass). Please park in the Metro Link lot.

Note: We do not accept new volunteers on December 30 and 31 because the float is judged on those days (scheduled precisely for 2:08 PM), and it's just too hectic to train newbies.

Interested visitors may watch the judging and, of course, the departure of the float as it heads to Pasadena on December 31 at about 7:00 PM. Come to the float Barn and wish us well!

The cycle continues: The Float Design Contest for the 2020 Rose Parade is going on right now! Visit our website at www.BurbankRoseFloat.com and download a contest entry form, which also includes a hint about the 2020 parade theme. The deadline for submitting an entry is January 30. You do not need to live in Burbank, nor do you need to be a member of our Association, to submit an entry.




