Van Nuys, California (February 18, 2015) John Burroughs High School Senior Griffin Armstorff at a recent ceremony at Congressman Brad Sherman's Van Nuys office received the Congressional Award Silver Medal for performing 200 hours of public service, 100 hours of personal development, 100 hours of physical fitness, and 7 days of exploration or expedition.


The Congressional Award is the United States Congress' award for young Americans. It is non-partisan, voluntary, and non-competitive. The program is open to all young people ages 14 to 23. Participants earn Bronze, Silver and Gold Congressional Award Certificates and Bronze, Silver and Gold Congressional Award Medals. Each level involves setting goals in four program areas; Volunteer Public Service, Personal Development, Physical Fitness, and Expedition/Exploration.

Griffin achieved his service hours through the Boy Scouts of America with his Eagle Service Project, the removal of over 5,000 invasive plants from the San Gabriel River bed, and service projects by other Boy Scouts, and Meals On Wheels. He also worked on service hours through The Actor's Fund Looking Ahead at Operation Gratitude, Project Angel Food, the Los Angeles Food Bank and Big Sunday.

For his physical fitness Griffin was a member of the John Burroughs High School swim team and water polo team. Griffin was also a member of the Media City Ballet Company and the Pacific Ballet Dance Theatre under the tutelage of Artistic Director Natasha Middleton. The physical fitness part of the award helps to improve the participant's quality of life through participation in fitness activities. The Congressional Award challenged Griffin to set and achieve a measurable goal in a physical activity.

For personal development Griffin participated at the Looking Ahead Leadership Council, Boy Scouts of America and through summer employment at Lucille Cowle Swim School as a swim instructor. Griffin also participated in the Washington Youth Summit on the Environment as part of the award program. The personal development part of the award expands the participant's horizons



day, by seeing who can catch the most yellow, orange or red

Team up for gardening.

Kids are great at digging (and getting dirty), so let them turn over the soil and help plant new bulbs. Research shows that gardening is as good as weight training when it comes to preventing osteoporosis. BONUS: If you're planting vegetables, helping in the garden can make them more appetizing to kids on a plate.


Kids' ideas.



Richard's previous design submittals. In addition to Burbank and Sierra Madre, the other four self-builts are Cal Poly (Pomona & San Luis Obispo), Downey, La Canada-Flintridge and South Pasadena.

In keeping with the parade theme of "Burbank – City of the Wild Wild West," we have brought back the gorilla as "sheriff" and several monkeys as "inmates" in a comically twisted jail cell. Human outwalkers will be maneuvering other "robber" monkeys during their get away! Thanks to Chairman Brian Cozakos and artist Ric Scozzari for their efforts!






