Connie Wilson's Word to the Wise:

Update your Estate Plan!

Longtime Burbank resident Connie Wilson, who celebrates her 94th birthday this month, had recently been feeling so ill that she thought it would be a good idea to double-check her will to make sure that everything was in order, just in case she didn't pull through. She was horrified to discover that changes in the law had nullified much of her will's intent.

"The laws of yesteryear are all completely outdated," said Wilson, beloved of several generations of Burbank locals who remember her from her 24-year tenure (1960-1984) as a librarian with the Burbank Unified School District, and later for her key role as a charter member of the Friends of the Burbank Public Library. "A person may think their will is set to help the



designated heirs, when in reality it may put those heirs in a terrible position," she said, adding that extremely high death taxes and expensive court-required probate

procedures are just a few of the lurking dangers.

Today, Wilson urges everyone, particularly the elderly, to review Continued on page 6

Lions' Kidsight Eye Screening Project Receives Excellence Award

It was a dream of the Burbank Noon Lions; initiate a KidSight project to screen the eyes of children for vision abnormalities in their critical, early developmental years, enabling them to grow and learn without limitations. The volunteers and technology were available to jump start the KidSight pilot project, but funding was in short supply.

With the help of a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) awarded by the Burbank City Council, the KidSight project became a reality. More than three years later, over 2,000 children, under the age of six, have received free eye screenings by Lions club members and volunteers. At the same time, following the free screenings, over 200 parents were shocked to learn that their young children had abnormal vision. In recognition of these accomplishments, KidSight Burbank recently received a 2014 CDBG award, presented by Congressman Adam Schiff. The Congressional Recognition Excellence Award was presented to honor CDBG recipient non-profits providing outstanding and invaluable service to the community.

Over 70 percent of juvenile delinquents have vision problems, and one child in four, entering school, has undiagnosed, abnormal vision. It is such statistics that motivated the Burbank Noon Lions to follow the Lions Club International motto to "prevent blindness", by offering the free screenings in child care centers, health fairs and low income housing venues. The muscles of the eyes are completely developed, no matter how imperfectly, by the age of



six. Undiagnosed vision problems can slow development, hand/eye coordination, balance and basic learning. Often, unacceptable behavior is misdiagnosed, as a disease, treated with strong medication, when in actuality, frustration, as a result of poor vision, is the culprit. A corrective pair of glasses, in many cases, is the simple remedy.

Individual and corporate sponsorships are being accepted to help continue KidSight Burbank. No staff is employed to coordinate and facilitate the project; instead KidSight volunteers perform all services needed; 100 percent of funding goes directly to project costs. field trip or at the joy of mastering a new skill. There is something new every day for them and me.'

But his favorite part is the sense of extended family at Y Camp. "There was a time when two of my charges were upset about being picked on at school. They didn't want to talk about it in front of me until their mom said, 'Consider Alex part of the family.' It made me feel really good about my positive, supporting role in these kids' lives.

Burbank resident Gabby Rodin, 21, was a student at the YMCA after-school program and a Y camper for three summers. She initially became a camp counselor to fulfill her school's volunteer hours requirement. But what she discovered was that she loves working with kids!

Now enrolled in the deaf studies program at California State University at Northridge, she recalls that taking a counselor role at the Y was a "natural fit," as she grew up with the Child Development Center staff.

Working with 6-11 year olds has taught Gabby patience and a new appreciation for simple things. It has also brought her great joy to see their excitement, hear their stories and watch their personal development. She highly recommends the opportunity to others because "Summer camp is so much fun."

Her favorite experience was last year when they staged a paint war (with nontoxic, water-based, parent-approved paint) during which the kids and counselors splashed each other until they looked like crazy rainbows. "We laughed so hard," she recalls, "but we also learned about fair-play and cleaning up!"

Gabby notes, "You have to be creative, enthusiastic and listen to work as a counselor—basic parenting skills.'

Enrollment for Burbank YMCA Summer camp is now open. Camp experience programs include basketball, gymnastics, architecture, superhero, wizards & magic, Olympics, adventure and more.

their wills regularly with professional estate planners to ensure that changes in law will not negate their wishes. The most important thing, she said, is to understand that your house is probably the single most valuable asset in your estate. Therefore, it is crucial that it be appraised accurately. The second most important step, according to Wilson, is to write out your wishes as to how you would like your property distributed after your death, take it to an estate lawyer to couch in the proper legal terminology, and have it notarized. Third, she said, is to appoint an executor and a trustee with care, as they are the ones who will be acting to carry out your will's instructions when the time comes.
