

Children Need Swim Lessons for Safe Summer Fun

There is a list of basic life skills all parents instinctively know they must teach their children to keep them safe and healthy. It includes habits like looking both ways before you cross the street, washing your hands with soap and water and eating the right amount of fruits and vegetables every day.

For too many parents, safety in and around water is not on the list; and that's something we need to change.

Fatal drowning is the second-leading cause of unintentional injury-related death for children ages one to 14 years old. In 2013, 60 children between ages zero to five died in California due to drowning. What's more, for every child who dies, another five receive emergency department care for nonfatal submersion injuries, which can result in life-long disabilities.



The YMCA introduced the concept of group swim lessons in 1909. Now, each year in 2,200 pools across the country, the Y teaches more than a million children from all backgrounds invaluable water safety and swim skills. Here in Burbank, the Y teaches over 1,500 children water safety and swimming each year, so they know what to do if they find themselves in the water unexpectedly, a situation every child should be equipped to handle.

The Burbank Community YMCA is committed to reducing water-related injuries in our town. Swim lessons are offered year-round at the Y, but summer is a popular time to start. Children as young as three can begin learning how to respond if they find themselves in unexpected water situations -- from how to reach the water's surface if they submerge to safely reaching a pool's edge or exiting any body of water. The Y also offers financial assistance to Family Members who qualify, so that children have access to these life-saving skills regardless of income.

If you know how to stay safe in and around water, swimming can be a lifelong source of fun and exercise. Instead of keeping your children away from water, help them learn fundamental water safety skills by enrolling them in lessons.



mechanics better access to the engines, transmission, hydraulic lines, etc. Our first formal Test Drive is still scheduled for early October.


