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



Building and decorating Burbank's float is a year-round activity. With a new and improved Aquatics program on the way, the Burbank YMCA gears up for big changes with new Aquatics Director, Jennifer Cervantes. I managed to catch Jennifer for a quick interview in between registrations and meetings for the upcoming season.

Q. How many years have you been active with the YMCA?

A. I'm going onto 6 years.

Q. What experience have you had with the YMCA through your 6 years?

A. The Y is life changing and very family oriented. It's not like your normal, average gym. You feel welcomed here at the Y. I feel that it's a place where a lot of children do come in and grow and learn from other children and build relationships with them.

Q. Fun question, do you have a favorite Olympic swimmer?


