Burbank Tournament of Roses Association

Everyone knows that the primary distinction of the Rose Parade is that all the beautiful floats are covered with natural floral materials. But what if you need to represent things that are already natural?

Using real trees to represent "tree" elements on your float will not impress the

judges with your creativity! You may also find that a picture-perfect tree is hard to find! However, by building a tree skeleton from steel and fastening real branches to the skeleton, you can create an idealized tree in which all of Mother Nature's "flaws" are corrected. If the float design calls for several 10-15 ft tall ideal trees, it will probably be less expensive to build the beautiful trees! Not sure? Check out the Christmas tree lots next December for yourself! Then check out the pile of scrap branches that you can get for nearly free!

Burbank's 2017 float, Home Tweet Home, will include a garden in the rear area. Like many gardens, this one will feature carrots and pumpkins. Deco Chairman Audrey Prest, must decide whether to use real pumpkins and carrots or to make them. The float already includes "birds" that range from three to five feet tall. Should garden elements be correspondingly scaled up? Real pumpkins might be recognizable as pumpkins. Would real carrots or carrots as big as your arm be better?




Construction Chairman Jon Reeves, is facing a rapidly approaching deadline! Test Drive 1 is scheduled for the first Saturday in October and work days seem to be in short supply! The inspectors will especially be looking at the driver compartment and the observer compartment and the associated hatchways. These compartments do not just exist in

empty space, a considerable amount of the float "pod" must be built as well! Several of the larger animated pieces have been built and are ready to be mounted, if only there was pod structure built.


Although not critical for the Test Drive milestone, fabrication of the construction-worker bird characters is progressing. Nearly all of the birds are built as separate pieces that will be decorated off-float then installed in their pre-built mounts. Several will include hydraulic cylinders and hoses to power the animated wing flaps or rotations. All of these "guts" must be finished before the characters can be screened, painted and decorated!


